Crazy Horse Canyon Landfill

(350 Crazy Horse Canyon Road, Salinas) will be closing to residential self hauls for trash and recycling disposal February 28th, 2009. For more information call Jose Gamboa at 831-775-3006.



If you flush expired medications down the toilet, they will pollute our water and waterways. The Monterey Regional Water Pollution Control Agency is asking residents to dispose of their expired medications by taking them back to their local pharmacy,

Salinas Valley Household Hazardous Waste Facility (139 Sun Street, Salinas), or removing the medications from their original containers? Residents may mix old medications with a waste material such as used kitty litter, ashes, or coffee grounds. Then place the bag mixture in an impermeable container such as a sealable bag before discarding in the trash.
