The CENSUS is coming!

The City of Salinas has joined the U.S Census Bureau to emphasize the importance of completing the Census questionnaire on April 1, 2010. **If residents are NOT counted, Salinas will lose both dollars and power.** The U.S Constitution requires a headcount of everyone living in the USA. The population numbers determine each state's Congressional representation.
